<u>Osier willow</u>	D	M	Early catkins for bees
<u>Goat willow</u>	D	M	Pussy willow catkins
<u>Hazel</u>	D	S	Catkins/nuts/wildlife habitat
<u>Rowan</u>	D	S	Flower/autumn berries/birds
<u>Wild Cherry</u>	D	M	Blossom/fruit/autumn colour
<u>Bird Cherry</u>	D	M	Blossom/scent/autumn colour
<u>Cherry Plum</u>	D	S	Blossom in February/fruit
<u>Crab Apple</u>	D	M	Blossom/fruit
<u>Hornbeam</u>	D	L	Stately/keeps leaf in autumn
<u>Wild Service Tree</u>	D	M	Blossom/fruit/autumn colour/rare
<u>Small-leaf Lime (linden)</u>	D	M	Limeflower (tea)/wildlife habitat
<u>Sweet Chestnut</u>	D	L	Chestnuts
<u>Holly</u>	E	S	Glossy leaf/winter berries/birds
<u>Elder</u>	D	S	Flower/scent and fruit
<u>Spindle</u>	D	S	Colourful fruit/wildlife habitat
<u>Whitebeam</u>	D	M	White growth & blossom/berries
<u>Juniper</u>	E	S	Berries/needs conservation
<u>Guelder Rose</u>	D	S	Blossom/autumn colour & berries
<u>Field Maple</u>	D	M	Gold in autumn/wildlife habitat
<u>Scots Pine</u>	E	L	Native pine/cones/wildlife habitat
<u>Holm Oak</u>	E	M	Glossy leaf/winter shelter for birds
